
## Legal Update

#### **Legal Guidance on International Travels**



#### <u>Overview</u>

Indonesian government is doing everything in its power to prevent the further spread of COVID-19 while also maintaining Indonesia's economy stability. One of their many efforts is making a COVID-19 Task Force who had issued COVID-19 Task Force Circular Letter No. 22/2022 regarding Health Protocols for International Travel during the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Pandemic.

Hence, in this Legal Guidelines, we have summarized the terms and conditions that need to be complied by international travelers (PPLN).



# Legal Update



#### Mentioned below are protocols requirements that need to be met by PPLN to enter Indonesia:

- 1. PPLN may enter Indonesia through the entry points of international travel mentioned below:
  - Airports
  - Seaports
  - Cross-border posts
- 2. Mentioned below are airports that only act as entry points for PPLN involved in the hajj program and will only be opened until August 15th, 2022:

- Sultan Iskandar Muda Airport
- Minangkabau Airport
- Mahmud Badaruddin II Airport
- Adisumarmo Airport
- Syamsuddin Noor Airport
- Sultan Aji Muhammad Sulaiman
   Sepinggan Airport
- 3. Foreign citizens who want to enter Indonesia must comply with the following regulations:
  - Indonesian laws & regulations
  - Bilateral agreement scheme
  - Granted special permission in a written form from related Ministries/Institution
- 4. At every entry point, PPLN must comply with the following requirements:
  - Complying with Indonesian government health protocols
  - Complying with Peduli Lindungi requirements before departure
  - Able to show a certificate of vaccine (with exceptions)
- 5. Indonesian PPLN aged 18 and above must show

- a certificate of COVID-19 third dose vaccination through Peduli Lindungi
- 6. Exceptions to the number prior are given to:
  - Indonesian PPLN with a medical certificate that states they have special health conditions and comorbidities which prevent them from getting vaccinated
  - o Indonesian PPLN with a medical certificate that states they were not able to be vaccinated after being infected with COVID-19 but no longer actively transmitting COVID-19
- 7. Dispensation is granted to Indonesian PPLN with urgent circumstances
- 8. The application used by transportation modes operator at every entry point of international travel is Peduli Lindungi
- 9. Cargo ships and crews' health quarantine will be monitored according to Indonesian laws & regulations
